
Discover Your Purpose in Life

Assess Where Life Can Intersect

1 and 4

Combining what you're good at with what can pay the bills might be your profession. But it may not bring you joy and peace, and it may not be good for the world. A life devoid of passion and a sense of accomplishment may quickly burn you out.

1 and 2

This combines what you love, and what you're good at. You will find your hobbies at this intersection. 2 and 3

1, 2, 3, and 4

Your purpose lies at the intersection of all four points – what you're good at, what you love, what the world needs, and what you can be paid for. How do these elements fit together in your life? You don't need to know the answer – just ask the questions and be open to the possibilities.
