# Preparing for an Enucleation: surgery to remove a sick eye Morgan Livingstone MA CCLS CIIT



Hi! I'm Kamau. I'm going to the hospital for special surgery. It's called an Enucleation.
That means removing my eye that is too sick.




## My caregiver will take me to **register** at the **hospital**.



We will wait in the **waiting room**. I can **play** or watch a **video**.





We will move to the **Pre-Op playroom** to wait for my turn in the **Operating Room**. I can play here.






**Nurses** may **weigh me** on a **scale** and help me to change into a **gown**. This keeps the operating


room clean.



I will wear the **gown**. Nurses, doctors and Child Life Specialists will wear special clothes called **Scrubs**.



In the **operating room** I will lay on a special table, with my head on a soft **round pillow**.





#### This is me laying on the **table** in the **Operating Room**.



#### The Operating room has big bright lights and equipment to help complete my procedure.





Next I will be given a special **sleepy medicine** that is like air. The **Anesthesiologist** will place a plastic **mask** over my nose and mouth so I can breathe in the medicine. I

will fall asleep.



Special **stickers** will be placed on my chest when I am asleep. These are connected to a machine that monitors my **heart** and my **breathing**.





A blood pressure cuff will be on my arm to monitor how my blood moves throughout my body.



I will receive a **brannula** or **Intravenous (IV)** in my **hand**. It is a **small straw** that can give my body **water** and **medicine** during my procedure through my **veins**.





My Eye Doctor, the **ophthalmologist**, has **special tools** that are just for my eyes. These tools help the doctor see my eye better.





#### My ophthalmologist wears a special device that magnifies what they look at, like my eye!






My doctor will use a **speculum** to help my eye stay **open**, and will use a **magnifying glass** to see my eye up close.





My doctor will use a **special tool** to safely remove my sick eye.







## After my sick eye is removed, the doctor will cover my eye socket with a bandage.



## After my **EUA** I will wake up in the recovery room with a **mask** on my face **blowing cool air.**



After a day or two, my doctor will take off the bandage. My eye lid may be closed and a bit swollen. This is normal.



#### I will be able to go home to heal and play.



When my eye socket is healed and ready I will meet the ocularist to make a **prosthetic eye**. The prosthetic eye will be made to look like my other eye.





Prosthetic eyes cannot see. My prosthetic fits into my socket and looks like my eye. Prosthetic eyes can be made in all eye colors for different people.
